Behavioral Cybersecurity Information Specialist

Behavioral Cybersecurity Information Specialists prepare detailed reports for cybersecurity teams. They also provide security analysis and create products based on analysis of security and counterintelligence data

Junior Cybersecurity Compliance Specialist

Junior Cybersecurity Compliance Specialists use security and compliance to support multiple IT projects, programs, and initiatives. Specialists make data-driven decisions that also take into consideration social and political trends in the region.

Salary: \$78k
